A Message from the President



It's hard to believe we are already planning for the holidays, but here we are. 

John Rupp named president of J.P. Weigand; Dawn Truman takes over as commercial division GM



John Rupp will become the company's president in January. Dawn Truman is transitioning from her role as president to become senior vice president of the entire company and general manager of its commercial division. She replaces Jerry Gray, who retired earlier this year.
