What is the size of your organization? 47 employees

What is your company's mission? Our mission is to enhance a community of learning excellence for our students and faculty through philanthropy and stewardship.

How is your company involved in the Wichita community? **As the fundraising arm of the university, we work directly with dozens of corporations in the Wichita community to support the mission and vision of Wichita State. Our Corporate Foundation Relations team helps connect giving with students, programs, colleges or faculty to increase opportunities at WSU while advancing corporate goals, further developing our local economy.**

What's an interesting fact about your business that others may not know? The staff members of the WSU Foundation fund the WSUF Core Values Scholarship in its entirety, awarding it to one student each year. This scholarship gives our staff members the opportunity to directly see the impact a gift can have on a student's life.

What does your company have planned for the future? Our primary role is to advance and support the mission of the university, which is to be an essential educational, cultural and economic driver for Kansas and the greater public good.
